**IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER**  
**Bryan Co. Rural Water Dist. #2 Did Not Meet Treatment Requirements.** Our water system recently violated a drinking water requirement pertaining to the contaminant(s) of concern listed below. Although none of these violations are considered emergencies, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we are doing, or have done, to correct these violations. Customers are not at risk and there is no reason to suspect any potential adverse health effects. Alternative water supplies are not needed. We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water meets health standards. During the following monitoring periods, we did not monitor or test for the following contaminants, and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time:

**What should I do?** There is nothing you need to do. **You do not need to boil your water or take other corrective actions.** However, if you have specific health concerns, a severely compromised immune system, have an infant, are pregnant, or are elderly, you may be at increased risk and should seek advice from your health care providers about drinking this water. **What happened? What is being done?** We are required to submit seven (7) Chlorine and seven (7) Total Coliform samples monthly. In June, the lab informed us that they had only received six (6) samples. We had no way of proving that we had submitted seven (7), therefore we were out of compliance. All samples have been collected and we have been back in compliance since July 1, 2024.
